PRE-EMPLOYMENT PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS PUBLIC SAFETY

Appointments for pre-employment physical examinations (PPEs) are done by appointment at:

Go back to BEHS 48-72 hours after your PPE to have your PPD skin test read, unless otherwise directed.

Bring immunization records.

Tell the staff that you're with Baltimore County General Government and that you're there for a "public safety pre-employment physical examination".

Allow at least 3 hours for the appointment.

Dress comfortably. Bring something to keep yourself busy. BEHS offers wireless access.

Bring valid photo ID.

Do not bring any children or other guests.

Your appointment will be cancelled if you are more than 10 minutes late.

You are responsible for completing your PPE.

You will receive and sign instructions if BEHS needs more information. BEHS will give you a deadline of 10 business days after your appointment.

Confirm with your provider that the information was sent. Confirm with BEHS that it was received. Keeping a copy for yourself and hand-delivering it to BEHS are best.

Your pre-employment physical is free. However, you must pay any fees associated with complying with BEHS's instructions. Fees include the costs related to seeing a specialist.
